Prayer and the Prophetic

I. Biblical Promises from God to us: the Word of the Lord.

This is an example of the prophetic promise of God in the Old Testament speaking of a future covenant coming. This is only one example out of a multitude of Words from the Lord that have come to pass (manifest). We can take these written Words of the Lord in our Bibles and pray them now. Watch God manifest His Word when we pray in agreement with what He has prophesied.

Jeremiah 32:37-43 God foretelling the New Covenant

This is my covenant

Hebrew 10:15&16

The Holy Spirit is a witness to us for he has said before (prophetic)... This is my covenant ...

I John 5: 14 & 15

Praying according to His will. We know He has heard and we have the petition of our hearts.

II. Personal Words from God to me

Examples of personal Words from the Lord to His Children

Luke 1:13

*An angel had been sent to Zacharias with the Word of the Lord.

“Fear not Zacharias for thy prayer is heard and thy wife Elizabeth shall bear thee a son and you shall call his name John.”

How did Zacharias react and what was the result of his reaction?
His mouth was shut.

Luke 1:28

*An angel had been sent to Mary with the Word of the Lord.

“Hail highly favored the Lord is with you. Blessed are you among women.”

“You shall conceive in your womb and bring forth a son and shall call his name Jesus.”

How did Mary react and what was the result of her action? Because she believed, the Spirit of the Lord filled her immediately and she sang a prophetic song.

She opened her mouth and worship and prayed a prophetic prayer.

III. The Glory Cycle:

Begins with the Word of the Lord. God releases His Word.

We pray the Word of the Lord and agree (Faith). The Word is Truth to us.

The Word of the Lord becomes manifest and made flesh in us.

VI. Additional Thoughts

The Word of the Lord is an invitation to agree, not a guarantee.

The Word of the Lord helps us persevere in prayer as we stand in faith.

Jesus spoke the Word of the Lord he was given the Spirit without measure.

The Word of the Lord is Spirit, Power, Truth, it will manifest.

The Word of the Lord releases the Kingdom of God in prayer.

Praying Prophetic prayers changes us to be like HIM.
